## Council Plans for the Gardens are Resolved

The Council's proposals to lease off part of Greenhill Gardens came to a conclusion in January 2015. After a call for Bids to take over the area only one was received. It was from the Greenhill Community Asset Management Group and had some interesting suggestions. No commercial bids had been received by the Council. The Council's decision is for them to retain full ownership and management of the area.

Your FOGG Committee decided not to make a bid for the lease but did make representations to the Council. Our views about the Gardens are in "Greenhill Gardens: Options for the Future." A copy of the document is on the FOGG Website.
